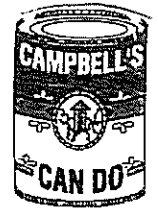

A motion was made by Trambly and seconded by Skupa to approve the City Clean-up on Saturday, April 16, sponsored by the Campbell Area Foundation with possible help from the youth from the three churches. Roll call: aye - 3, nay - 0.

2. Discuss purchase of riding mower

The following action item was tabled until the September meeting:

1. Review bids for heater at Power House

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:17 p.m. to the call of the Chair.

Again we are asking each individual to take their own trash to the dump.

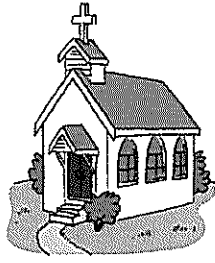
