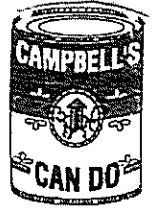

CAMPBELL BLOODMOBILE

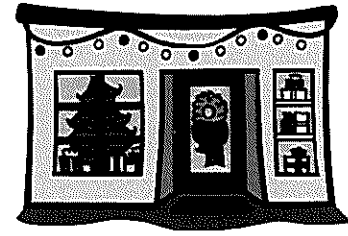

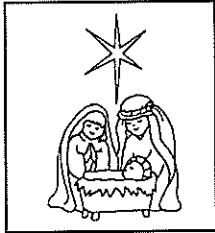
