There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:04 a.m. to the call of the Chair.

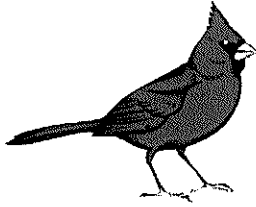

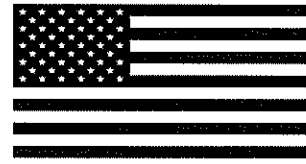
## PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH SPRING TEA

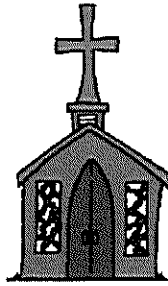
