Mike Schultes, with JEO Consulting, and Keith Brooman, with Sargent Drilling presented additional options for upgrading the well part of our water project.

A motion was made by Skupa and seconded by L'Heureux to amend the original bid from Sargent Drilling and add flow meters to the west and the north wells and to add a heat unit to the north well. Roll call: aye - 4, nay - 0.

A motion was made by L'Heureux and seconded by Pearson to amend the original bid from Sargent Drilling and not go with the filters. Roll call: aye - 4, nay - 0.

The Board reviewed the One- and Six-Year Street Improvement program and will take action on it at the Public Hearing in February.

A motion was made by Lang and seconded by Skupa to go into executive session at 6:44 p.m. to discuss employee wages. Roll call: aye - 4, nay - 0.

A motion was made by Skupa and seconded by Pearson to come out of executive session at 7:05 p.m. Roll call: aye - 4, nay - 0.

A motion was made by Lang and seconded by Pearson to increase employee wages by \$0.15/hour effective with current pay period. Roll call: aye - 4, nay - 0.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:08 p.m. to the call of the Chair.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said in unison.

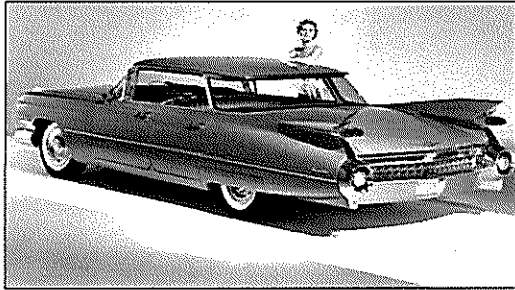
The purpose of the meeting was to discuss future use of Grandview Manor.

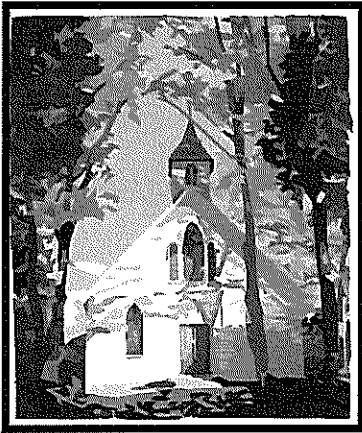
