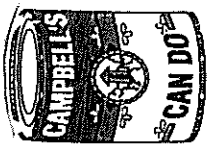

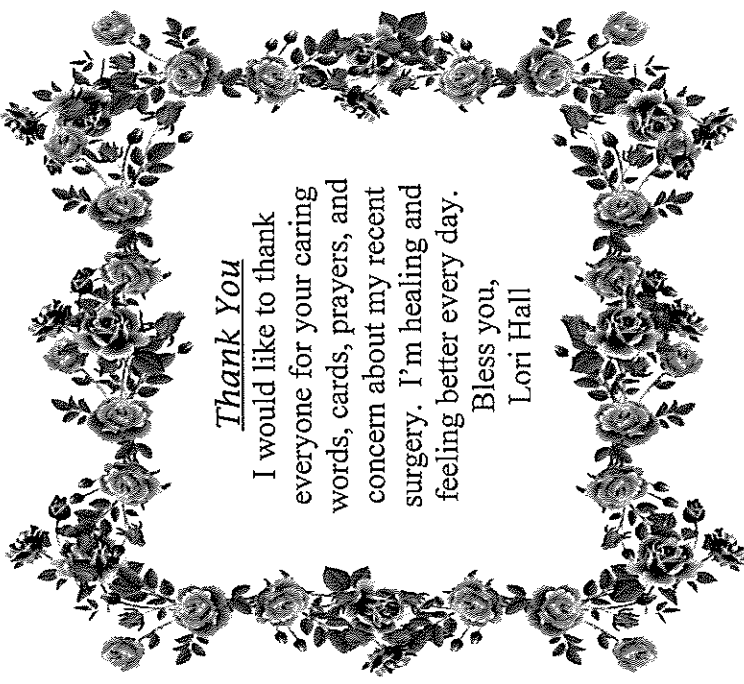
## CAMPBELL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

TUESDAY, MAY 14, 2019

The Village of Campbell Board of Trustees held its Regular Meeting in the Community Hall at 7:45 a.m. with Chairman Steve Skupa and Trustees Rodney Lang, Greg L'Heureux, Bill Pearson and Nelson Trambly present. Absent: none. Jeanie Schmidt, Ron Pankoke, Chet Hart and Keith Klatt were also present.

A motion was made by Trambly and seconded by Skupa to adopt Ordinance 19-2 approving a Loan Resolution with USDA in the amount of \$702,000. Roll call: aye - Lang, L'Heureux, Pearson, Skupa, Trambly; nay - 0. A complete copy of the ordinance is on file in the clerk's office.

A motion was made by Skupa and seconded by L'Heureux approve Change Order #1 for Midlands Contracting Inc. for +\$3,408.70. Roll call: aye - 5, nay - 0.

A motion was made by L'Heureux and seconded by Lang to approve Pay Application #1 and Final for Midlands Contracting Inc. for \$79,868.70. Roll call: aye - 5, nay - 0.

A motion was made by Pearson and seconded by Trambly to approve the Certificate of Substantial Completion for Midlands Contracting Inc. Roll call: aye - 5, nay - 0.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:40 a.m. to the call of the Chair.
